## THE KERALA APPROPRIATION (No. 17) BILL, 2008

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## **BILL**

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala for the services of the financial year 2008-09.

*Preamble.*—Whereas, it is necessary to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala for the services of the financial year 2008-09;

BE it enacted in the Fifty ninth year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. *Short title.*—This Act may be called the Kerala Appropriation (No. 17) Act, 2008.
- 2. Issue of Rs. 763,95,48,000 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala for the services of the financial year 2008-09.—From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Rupees Seven Hundred and Sixty three Crore Ninety Five Lakh Forty Eight Thousand only towards defraying the several charges which will come in the course of payment during the financial year 2008-09, in respect of the services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule.
- 3. Appropriation.—The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes specified in the Schedule in relation to the financial year 2008-09.

## STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The Bill is introduced in pursuance of clause (1) of article 204 of the Constitution of India read with article 205 thereof, to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala required to meet the supplementary expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala and the grants made by the Legislative Assembly for the expenditure of the Government of Kerala for the financial year 2008-09.
