(Report of the Subject Committee)

Subject Committee I (Agriculture, Animal Husbandry and Fisheries) to which the Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (Amendment) Bill, 2013 (Bill No. 200) was referred, considered the Bill clause by clause and now submits this Report with the Bill as reported by the Committee annexed thereto.

2. The Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (Amendment) Bill, 2013 was published as a Gazette Extraordinary dated March 16, 2013. The Bill was introduced in the Assembly on March 25, 2013 and was referred to the Subject Committee on the same day.

3. The Committee considered the Bill clause by clause at its meeting held on March 25, 2013 and the Committee recommends to adopt the Bill without any modification.

BILL

to amend the Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University Act, 2010.

Preamble.—WHEREAS, it is expedient to amend the Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University Act, 2010 for the purpose hereinafter appearing ;

BE it enacted in the Sixty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) This Act may be called the Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (Amendment) Act, 2013.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 26th day of March, 2012.

2. *Amendment of section 57.*—In the Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University Act, 2010 (3 of 2011), (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), in sub-section (7) of section 57 for the words “fifty-five years”, the words “fifty-six years” shall be substituted.

3. *Repeal and saving.*—(1) The Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (Amendment) Ordinance, 2013 (26 of 2013) is hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or deemed to have been done or any action taken or deemed to have been taken under the principal Act, as amended by the said Ordinance shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the principal Act as amended by this Act.
