The meeting of Self Financing Medical / Dental College managements was held on 28.05.2011 at Govt. Guest House, Thycaud, Thiruvananthapuram under the chairmanship of the Hon'ble Minister (Health & Coir) to discuss and finalize the issues regarding the sharing of seats and fee structure for Post Graduate Medical/Dental seats.

At the outset, the Secretary (Medical Education) welcomed the participants to the meeting and informed about the objects of the meeting that is

- a) there should be equal distribution of clinical & non-clinical seats between merit seat and management seats
- b) fee structure
- c) to inform that the cut off date for PG admission (Government merit quota will be 30/06/2011)

and requested their co operation for conducting the PG admission. The Hon'ble Minister stated that Government want to have a cordial relationship with the Self Financing managements and said that Government and the managements have to co operate together in all aspects. The Secretary, Kerala Private Medical College Management Association expressed concern over the cut off date of PG admission. The cut of date for PG admission as per the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court is 31.05.2011. He said that they are willing to share 50% seats under Government merit. But Government have not provided the list of students under General merit to the SFC's even after 25.05.2011 and hence they may be forced to fill those seats of their own before 31.05.2011. Otherwise there is every chances of getting those seats lapsed. The Co-ordinator, Kerala Christian Professional College Management Federation has also expressed the same feelings. The Dental College managements requested that Government should take up the matter with the Advocate General for obtaining extension of cut off date from the Hon'ble Supreme Court. The Secretary (Medical Education) informed the meeting that the Government have already requested the Advocate General to move the Hon'ble Supreme Court for extension of cut off date for PG admission upto 30.06.2011. The Director of Medical Education said that the Supreme Court have already extended the cut off date for the 2<sup>nd</sup> round counseling of All India Quota admission upto 30.06.2011 and the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of Counseling of general merit seats under State Quota can be done only after the extended 2<sup>nd</sup> round counseling of All India Quota. She opined that hence the extended cut off date is applicable to the Government merit seats in Self Financing Colleges also. But the management representatives argued that this order of the Apex Court meant only for the All India Quota and the seats in SFC's do not come under its purview. The representatives of management were again explained the version of the DMF that extended cut off date is applicable to the Government merit seats in self financing colleges and were requested to abide by the same.

The Hon'ble Minister said that Government is willing to help the managements, only if they are co operating with the Government. He suggested that there should be equal distribution of seats of the sanctioned Clinical and Non Clinical subjects in SFC's under Government merit and Management Quota. The Secretary (Medical Education) said that the managements are offering more Non Clinical subjects under Government merit instead of equal distribution of Clinical and Non Clinical subjects and this is clearly against the spirit of consensus with the Government and the Managements. The Representative of the managements remarked that they have to meet huge financial burden for installation of equipments for running Clinical Departments and the managements may be allowed to fill all the sanctioned Clinical seats in certain specialities of their own for at least this academic year. The Minister said that their request shall be considered favourably and opined that they have to give 50% of the faculty wise total sanctioned seats. It is decided that the fee structure for the seats shall be decided later and the Hon'ble Minister requested the managements to submit proposals in this regard urgently. The Co-ordinator, Kerala Christian Professional College Management Federation informed that they have already filled up some of their seats under merit quota since they did not get any communication from Government. The Hon'ble Minister expressed strong displeasure on the action of the managements in having filled up the seats before arriving at a consensus with the Government in this regard and said that they should reconsider their decisions taken against the consensus with the Government, if any.

It was decided that Government should once again take up the matter for extension of cut off date upto 30.06.2011 before the Hon'ble Supreme Court/MCI/DCI for the completion of Government Merit seats both in Government and Self Financing Medical /Dental Colleges. A copy of the Government letter addressed to MCI/DCI may also be forwarded to the Self Financing Institutions for information.

The meeting ended at 11.45 AM with vote of thanks to the chair.
