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The Director of Mining and Geology in his letter read as 2nd paper above hasrecommended and forwarded an application received from M/s. Ashapura Minechem Ltd. Mumbai read as 1st paper above for grant of Mining Lease for Bauxite Aluminous Laterite and China Clay over an area of 675,9895 Hectares comprised in Sy Nos. 274, 248, 246, 156, 198 of Kinanuru Village, Hosdurg Taluk in Kasargode District for a period of 30 years.\_

- 2) The revenue records reveal that part of the area applied for has been assigned earlier and as such only 200 acres of revenue puramboke land only is available for grant for the purpose of extraction of the mineral. Hence Government recommended only 80.937 hectares (200 acres) of land in Re-Survey No.198/pt for approval of Government of India as per the letter read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above.
- 3) As per the letter read as 4th paper above, Government of India conveyed their approval under Section 5(1) of Mines and Minerals(Development & Regulation) Act, 1957 to the grant of Mining Lease for Bauxite & Aluminous Laterite over an area of 80.937 hexares in Kinanuru Village, Kasargod District to M/s Ashapura Minechem Ltd for a period of 30 years subject to the compliance of the amended provisions of the Mines & Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act/1957 and Mineral Concession Rules 1960 & other applicable Acts and Rule including Forest Conservation Act 1980 & Environment Notification Dated, 27.1.94 as issued and amended by McEF.
- 4) Government have examined the matter in detail in the light of the recommendation of the Director of Michig and Geology and the approval of

Sovernment of India and are pleased to grant Mining Lease to M/s Astro Minechem Ltd for Mining Bauxite & Aluminous Laterite over an area of 80.93 hectares in Kinanuru Village, Kasargod District for a period for 30 years under Section 5(1) of the Mines & Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957, subject to the following conditions and special conditions.

- 1. Royalty is payable as per sub section (2) of Section 9 of Mines & Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957.
- 2. Dead Rent is payable as per Sub Section (1) of Section 9-A of the Mines & Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957,
- 3. The mining lease deed in Form 'K' shall be executed within six months of the order of the grant of mining lease.
- 4. A Mining Plan duly approved by the authority empowered in this behalf shall be produced within a period of six months of the grant or before execution of the lease deed whichever is earlier.
- 5. The mined out area should be reclaimed up to the level of the surrounding
- 6. While Mining air/sound/water pollution shall be kept to at permissible limit.
- Mining should be carried out without causing disturbance to the local residents.
- 8. Financial Assurance should be given as per the provisions contained in the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 1988 before execution of mining leasa d<del>e</del>ad.

## Special Conditions

- 1. Consent of the owners of the residential buildings located within 50 metres of the area applied for mining lease should be produced by the lessee.
- 2. Before entry into the lease area under this grant the lessee shall produce from trie District Collector, Kasargod, NOC for a period of 30 years from the date of registration of the mining lease deed for conducting mining in the Government lands specified therein. The grantee shall further produce consent on stamp paper worth Rs.50/- each the consent from the owners of each private land holding involved in the area covered under this grant together with Possession Certificate from the relevant Village Officer to prove such ownership.
- 3. The mining activities under this grant shall be strictly confined to the area lying
- 4. A quarrying permit holdernease holder should exhibit a notice board both in English and Malayaiam for the information of the public at the entrance of the quarry containing the details viz. License No., validity period of the permit, Name of the permittlease holder, quantity permitted to be extracted etc.

The terms and conditions shall be subject to such further modifications and alterations as may be made by Government from time to time.

The Director, Survey and Land Records, Thiruvananthapuram will survey and prepare a cadastral map of the area on a suitable scale showing therein the area with the Sy.Nos, and sub divisions. The boundary survey Nos. with sub divisions will be delineated on the sketch. The area covered under this grant will be coloured in red and indexed accordingly. Three copies of the map in ORIGINAL under signature and office seal of the Director of Survey and Land Records will be furnished to the Director of Mining and Geology,

5) The Director of Mining and Geology will ensure the compliance of the amended provisions of the Mines & Minerals (Cevelopment & Regulation) Act, 1957 and Mineral Concession Rules 1960 and other Applicable Acts & Rules including Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and Environmental Notification Dated, 27.1.1994 as issued and amended by MOEF.
