**ORDER**

One of the long lasting demands of the Fire and Rescue Force Personnel is to treat their training period as duty and to reckon the training period as qualifying service for increment, grade promotion and pension. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that the training period including final examination of all categories namely Fireman, Fireman Driver cum Pump Operator, Driver Mechanic and Station Officer in the entry cadre, now in service should be treated as duty for all purposes.

Their joining duty after the successful completion of training and examination, and also the period of extension of training if any shall also be treated as officiating service for the purpose of increment pension and probation.

Suitable amendments will be made in the Special Rules read as first paper in due course.



**ORDER**

As per Government Order read as Ist paper above Government had ordered that the training period including final examination of all categories namely Fireman, Fireman Driver-cum Pump Operator, Driver Mechanic and Station Officer in their entry cadre now in service shall be treated as duty for al purposes.

2. Consequent to the above, the Commandant General, Kerala Fire & Rescue Services in his letter read as 2nd paper above has requested that since 9th pay revision fixation from 7/2009 of the Fire & Rescue personnel was already over, an additional increment may be sanctioned to the personnel who have under gone one year training and hence sanction be given revising the present increment date prior to 6 months or the month to the category Fireman Driver-cum Pump Operator and Driver Mechanic as per their training period with effect from 1/6/2011 the date of accrual of their increment as per their option.

3. Government have examined the proposal in detail and are pleased to sanction one additional increment to the category of Station Officer (Direct Recruitment) Fireman (Direct Recruitment) as per the training period with effect from 01.06.2011 . Sanction is also accorded, revising the present increment rate prior to 6 months or 4 months to the category of Fireman Driver -cum Pump Operator and Driver Mechanic in proportion to their period of training with effect from 01.06.2011 the date of accrual of their increment as per their option detailed below.

Sl. No.	Name of Category of Post	Period of Training	Details of increment to be given with effect from 1/6/2011
1	Station Officer (Direct Recruitment)	1 year	One additional increment
2	Fireman (Direct Recruitment)	1 year	One additional increment
3	Driver Mechanic (Direct Recruitment)	4 Months	Increment may be given 4 months prior to the normal Increment date (Max. 4 months exemption)
4	Fireman Driver-cum Pump Operator (Direct Recruitment) (Prior to the present Special Rule)	6 Months	Increment may be given 6 months prior to the normal Increment date (Max. 6 months exemption)
5	Fireman Driver-cum Pump Operator (Direct Recruitment) (As per present Special Rule)	4 Months	Increment may be given 4 months prior to the normal Increment date (Max. 4 months exemption)
