

ORDER

As per the Government Order read as first paper above Government have modified the O.P. timing of the Peripheral health institutions viz Community Health Centres, Primary Health Centres and dispensaries under Health Service Department as 9 AM to 1 PM and 2 PM to 3 PM. In the order it was also been clarified that the timing of Paramedical Staff will also be same as above.

As per the letter read as second above the Director of Health Services has informed that there is no comprehensive order by defining the duty timing of Paramedical Staff in minor and major hospital inforce except the above said order. As such the duty timing of Paramedical Staff in major hospitals under Directorate of Health Services and Directorate of Medical Education has not been defined so far. This create a lot of difficulties in various Government Hospitals. Accordingly Government have discussed the matter with the officials of Directorate of Health Services and Directorate of Medical Education and also with representatives to various service organizations of Paramedical Staff and decided to modify the working hours and duties and responsibilities of Paramedical Staff under Directorate of Health Services and Directorate of Medical Education and decided to implement the same as detailed below

- i. The duty time of all the Paramedical Staff will be 8 hours a day or 48 hours a week.
- ii. In all the emergency department and causality services, all the Staff will be on 24 hour as call duty to attend to emergencies and mass causality.
- iii. Shift duty of Paramedical staff will be done as follows:

Primary Health Centers which work 8 am to 4 pm with lunch break off 1 hour from 1 pm 2 pm in all 7 days - Single shift
 Community Health Centers and Specialty Hospitals where Causality Service is not provided } - 2 Shifts
 (8 AM to 4 PM with one hour lunch break from 1 PM to 2PM and 12 PM to 8PM)
 Taluk Hospitals and above and where causality services are provided } - 3 shifts
 (8 AM to 2 PM, 2 PM to 8 PM and 8 PM to 8 AM)

- iv. Night duty will not be considered double duty. Duty off not exceeding one duty shift (8 hours) will be admissible for one night shift and should be availed on the next day of night duty only.
- v. Weekly off will be admissible as per the existing norms of nurses.
- vi. The Paramedical Staff will be entitled to 20 days Casual Leave 22 holiday/ Compensatory Leave and 52 weekly off in addition to eligible leave.

ORDER

Considering the several requests received from various service organizations, Government have decided to modify the Government Order read above as follows:

The day/shift duty timings of Paramedical Staff in Primary Health Centres is fixed as 9 AM - 4PM with lunch break from 1-2 pm and in CHCs/Special hospitals without casualty as 9 AM - 4PM with lunch break from 1-2 pm and 7 am - 8 pm. No exemption is allowable for senior grade technicians and other Paramedical Staff from night shift duty.

The above Government Order stands modified to this effect.
