

ORDER

As per G.O read as 1st above Govt. have constituted a State Water and Sanitation Committee, consisting of an Apex Committee and an Executive Committee. Vide G.O read as 2nd and 3rd above District Water and Sanitation Committee had also been constituted for the effective implementation of community led Rural Water Supply Schemes in the state.

Govt. of India have issued comprehensive Revised Guidelines of National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) which came into force w.e.f 01-04-2009. The Revised Guidelines inter alia suggest the formation of SWSM (State Water and Sanitation Mission), DWSM (District Water and Sanitation Mission) and VWSC(Village Water & Sanitation Committee) for the integrated implementation of the scheme.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to constitute State Water and Sanitation Mission(SWSM)consisting of an Apex Committee and an Executive Committee,DWSC (District Water and Sanitation Committee) and VWSC(Village Water & Sanitation Committee).

The composition of the Apex Committee of SWSM will be as follows:

The apex Committee of SWSM shall meet at least once in every quarter and not less than four times in a year.

The functions of SWSM is as follows:-

- To provide policy guidance on water ,Sanitation,Health etc
- Periodic review of implementation of the MoU signed with the department of Drinking Water Supply,Gol.
- Consideration and Approval of all schemes pertaining to Water Supply and Sanitation sector programmes funded wholly or partially by the Govt. of India or the External Funding Agencies.

- Convergence of Water Supply and Sanitation activities including special projects;
- Coordination with various State Govt. Depts. and other partners in relevant activities;
- Monitoring and evaluation of physical and financial performance and management of the water supply and sanitation projects.
- Arranging independent certification of the quality of construction of Swajaldhara projects;
- Integrating and operating communication and capacity development programmes for both water supply and sanitation.

Functions of DWSC

- Formulation, management and monitoring of projects,
- Scrutiny of the Project proposals, selection of agencies and /NGOs and enter into MoUs for social mobilization, capacity development, communication, project management and supervision.
- Sensitizing the Public representatives, officials and the general public about the Swajaldhara principles;
- Engaging Institutions for imparting training for capacity development of all stakeholders, and undertaking communication campaign; and
- interaction with SWSM, State Government and the Government of India

Composition of VWSC (Village Water & Sanitation Committee) will be as follows:

Grama Panchayath President -- Chairman

Members will be decided by State Government under the Panchayath Act including women, SC, ST, poorer sections of society, subject matter specialists, NGOs, CBOs etc. of which at least one third of members should be women.

Functions of VWSC

- Ensuring Grama Panchayats to take up project implementation in each Gram Sabha meeting;
- Ensuring community participation and decision making in all phases of scheme activities;
- Organizing community contributions towards capital costs, both in cash and kind (land, labour or materials) opening, and managing bank account for depositing community cash contributions, O&N funds and management of project funds;
- signing of various agreements with the DWSC;
- Planning, designing, and implementing all water and sanitation activities;
- Procuring construction materials/ goods and selection of contractors (where necessary) and supervision of construction activities;
- Commissioning and takeover of completed water supply and sanitation works through a joint inspection with DWSC;
- Collection of funds through a tariff, charges and deposit system for O&M of water supply and sanitation works for proper managing and financing of O&N of the services on a sustainable basis; and empowering of women for day to day operation and repairs of the scheme.
- Creating and promoting integration of drinking water, sanitation and hygiene in the Panchayat; and
- Participation in communication and development activities in other villages.

As per the decision of the SLSC meeting held on 22-06-2009, Kerala Rural Water Supply & Sanitation Agency is designated as State Level Water & Sanitation Support Organisation (WSSO) under SWSM. WSSO will be an administrative body and its main functions will be the following:

- To act as a facilitating agency would function as a bridge between PHED/Board and community organisation.
- To assist the PRIs and VWSCs to prepare Community based water supply plan and project
- When all the base data on water resources, water quality data, water and sanitation disease burden data is available, SWSSO will assist the PRIs to develop water security and Safety plan.
- This organisation would only deal with all software aspect of RWS section and would not involve in implementation of water supply schemes.
- To take up evaluation studies, impact assessment studies and R&D activities.
- To take up IEC & HRD activities.
- MIS & computerisation programme, GIS mapping and online monitoring system.

SWSM will initiate action in the selection of Bank with internet connectivity for opening up of an account at the State Head Quarters.

A committee consisting of officials from KWA, WASCON, retired scientists from Central Ground Water Board / other technical institutions will be constituted as State Technical Agency (STA). Kerala Water Authority will initiate action in this regard.


A committee consisting of officials from KWA, KRWSA and CCDU will be constituted to prepare State specific sector policy framework and prepare the MoU. CCDU will take initiative in this regard.
