

CHAPTER 2

PROCEDURE FOR APPOINTMENT AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE OF CHAIRPERSON AND MEMBERS

3. *Eligibility for Appointment as Chairperson and Members.*—(1) No person who has not attained the age of 35 years and has not possess ten years experience in the areas stated in clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 17 of the Act may be appointed as Chairperson or Member of the Commission.

(2) No person having any past record of violation of human rights or child rights shall be eligible for appointment as Chairperson or Member of the Commission.

(3) No person having been convicted and sentenced for imprisonment of an offence which in the opinion of the Government involves moral turpitude, shall be eligible for appointment as Chairperson or Member of the Commission.

(4) No person having been removed or dismissed from service of the Central Government or a State Government or a body or corporation owned or controlled by the Central Government or a State Government shall be eligible for appointment as Chairperson or Member of the Commission.

(5) The Chairperson or Member shall not be a Member of Parliament or be a Member of Legislature of any State and shall not hold any office of trust or profit other than his office as Chairperson or Member. In case he carries on any business or practices any profession, he shall suspend as the case may be such business of practice before he assumes his office.

4. *Selection Procedure.*—(1) The Chairperson and the Members of the Commission shall be appointed on the recommendation of a three Member Selection Committee constituted by the Government under the Chairmanship of the Minister of Social Welfare.

(2) For the purposes of selection of the Chairperson and Members of the Commission, the Government shall invite applications from qualified candidates from the public through an advertisement in at least two leading national and vernacular dailies. The Government shall prepare a short list from the applications so received. The short listed candidates shall be selected on merit and interview by the Selection Committee. Such selected candidates shall be recommended by the Selection Committee to the Government for appointment.

(3) The selection procedure shall be fair and transparent.

(4) The Selection Committee shall also prepare a wait list of two persons for each of the posts. The wait list shall be valid for three months.

ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 1st paper above, Government have framed the Kerala State Commission for Protection of Child Rights Rules, 2012. As per the Government Order read as 2nd paper above, Smt.Neela Gangadharan IAS (Rtd) has been appointed as the Chairperson, Kerala State Commission for Protection of Child Rights for a period of 3 years.

Government are pleased to fix the following terms and conditions of appointment of Smt.Neela Gangadharan IAS (Rtd), as the Chairperson, Kerala State Commission for Protection of Child Rights.

Appointment:-

- (i) Her appointment as Chairperson of Kerala State Commission for Protection of Child Rights shall be for a period of 3 years from 3rd June 2013, the date on which she assumed charge of the Commission.
- (ii) She shall have the rank and status of Chief Secretary.
- (iii) She shall report to the Minister, Social Justice, Government of Kerala.

ii Pay and Other Allowances:-

- (i) She shall be eligible for last pay drawn minus pension as per Rule 100 Part III KSRs, and as per (Rule 9(1) of the Government Order read as 1st paper above.
- (ii) She shall be eligible for Dearness Allowance prescribed/revised by the Government of India from the time to time on the full basic pay.
- (iii) During the period when she draws Dearness Allowance, she shall not be entitled simultaneously to Dearness Relief on the basic pension.

III **HRA & Other Allowances:-**

- (i) She shall be entitled to House Rent Allowance as per the rate admissible to an Officer in the equivalent rank in the Government as stipulated in Rule 13 (2) of the Government Order read as 1st paper above.
- (ii) She shall be entitled to all other allowances (including AIS Officers' Allowance) as applicable to an AIS Officer of equivalent rank in Government of Kerala.

4. **Leave, LTC, Surrender of Earned Leave, etc:-**

- (i) Leave Rules shall be applicable to her as per appendix VIII, KSRs, Part I.
- (ii) Surrender of Earned leave shall be allowed in terms of G.O.(P) No. 47/2006/Fin. dated 30.01.2006.
- (iii) **LTC:-** Shall not be applicable as she is re-employed after her retirement vide 3 (b) of G.O.(P) No. 5/2013/Fin. dated 02.01.2013.

5. **TA, DA:-** She shall be guided by Rule 12(1) of the G.O.(P) read as 1st paper above.

6. **Medical Benefits:-** Shall be as per Rule 15 of the Government Order read as 1st paper above.

7. **Telephone, Mobile phone & Broad Band connection:-** Shall be payable as per the provisions in G.O.(Ms) No. 83/11/Fin dated 25.02.2011.




