(എ) പത്തനംതിട്ട ജില്ലാ പോലീസ് മേധാവിയായിരുന്ന ശ്രീ.രാഹുൽ. ആർ.നായർ, കൊരി ഉടമകളിൽ നിന്ന് 17 ലക്ഷം രൂപ കോഴി വാങ്ങിയതായുള്ള ആക്ഷേപം സംബന്ധിച്ച വിജിലൻസ് റിപ്പോർട്ട് ലഭിച്ചിട്ടുണ്ടോ; പ്രസ്തുത കേസിൽ വിജിലൻസ് അനേകഷണ ഉദ്യോഗസ്ഥൻ എഫ്.എഫ്.ആർ. തയ്യാറാക്കി രജിസ്റ്റർ ചെയ്തത് എപ്പോഴായിരുന്നു ; എഫ്.എഫ്.ആർ.ഈ.എ.എ.എഫ്.ആർ. ഒരു പകർപ്പ് ലഭ്യമാക്കാമോ ;

(എ) ശ്രീ. രാഹുൽ.ആർ. നായർക്കെൽക്കേ നടത്തിയ അനേകഷണ റിപ്പോർട്ടിന്റെ അടിസ്ഥാനത്തിൽ തിയാന്തതിര വി.സി.5/14-എസ്.എ.യു-I നമ്പറായി ഒരു വിജിലൻസ് കേസ് 17/11/14-ൽ രജിസ്റ്റർ ചെയ്ത് അനേകഷിച്ചുവരുന്നു. ഇതുമായി ബന്ധപ്പെട്ട എഫ്.എഫ്.ആർ. 17/11/14 തീയതിയിൽ രജിസ്റ്റർ ചെയ്തു. എഫ്.എഫ്.ആർ.-എ.എഫ്.ആർ.പ്രൈമീസ് പകർപ്പ് അനുബന്ധമായി ചേർത്തിട്ടുണ്ട്.

dtd 11.06.2014, by the Director, VACB against, Shri. Rahul R. Nair IPS, former District Police Chief, Pathanamthitta revealed the following:

Shri. Rahul R. Nair IPS, ordered the closure of Shanio Metal Caster Kothancherry on 01.03.2014 and thereafter on 04.05.2014 ordered its reopening without any justifiable or valid legal grounds. The Sub. Inspector of Police, Kolparam Police Station was directed over phone by Shri. Rahul R. Nair to check the quarry even before the anonymous petition received by District Police Chief at his camp office was forwarded to the Sub Inspector of Police.

Shri. Rahul R. Nair, former District Police Chief Pathanamthitta demanded Rs. 200000/- (Rupees twenty lakhs only) from Shri. Payest Thomas for allowing resumption of the operation of Shanio metal Caster and gave Shri. Payest Thomas, the mobile number of Shri. Ajithkumar as his middleman for further transactions. Frequency, duration and patterns of the calls between Shri. Rahul R. Nair and Shri. Ajithkumar during the end of April and first half of May, 2014 also reveal the design of the two in the transactions and negotiations relating to closure and re-opening of the quarry.

Shri. Rahul R. Nair, abused his official position as a public servant by ordering the closure of quarry without any legal authority vested in him. Similarly, his demand for illegal gratification and receipt of the same through his middleman, Shri. Ajithkumar are reflections of the criminal misconduct on his part.

Shri. Ajithkumar, negotiated with Shri. Payest Thomas with regard to the cash to be paid to Shri. Rahul R. Nair for the reopening of Shanio metal Caster and received Rs. 170000/- (Rupees seventeen lakhs only) from Shri. Payest Thomas at Kinnakulam on 04.05.2014 as middlemen on behalf of Shri. Rahul R. Nair for reopening of Shanio metal Caster.

From the above, it is prima facie disclosed in the enquiry that Shri. Rahul R. Nair IPS, in capacity as a public servant abused his official authority and committed criminal misconduct.

is the exercise of his official duty by ordering closure of Shensio Metal Crusher without any justifiable legal ground or initiating any criminal action against the licensee, thereafter demanding illegal gratification for himself from Shri. Payesh Thomas who met Shri. Rahul R. Nair at District Police Office Pathanamthitta, directing Shri. Payesh Thomas to contact his middleman Shri. Ajithkumar, and ordering resumption of the operation of Shensio Metal Crusher through S.I of Police Kozipram after the receipt of bribe of Rs 170000/- (Seventeen lakhs rupees only) on behalf of Shri. Rahul R. Nair on 04.05.2014 at Ernakulam. Thus Shri. Rahul R. Nair acted with the criminal motive of obtaining pecuniary advantage for himself. The above actions of Shri. Rahul R. Nair amount to commission of offence u/s 7, 13 (i) (d) of the P.C Act 1988. Shri. Ajithkumar acting as the middle man of Shri. Rahul R. Nair negotiated in the matter and accepted Rs 170000/- (rupees Seventeen lakhs only) as illegal gratification for Shri. Rahul R. Nair and thereby committed Offence u/s 8 of P.C Act 1988.

Enquiry also revealed similar kind of abuse of official position and criminal misconduct of Shri. Rahul R. Nair. Shri. Rahul R. Nair has ordered the closure and reopening of other metal crusher units functioning in Pathanamthitta district including Southern Granite Industries, Ramni without

- any legal justifiable ground. For exercising this practice, he utilised the service of shadow police who were under his direct control after bypassing local police officers who are supposed to take legal actions against criminal violations involving querries.

The Director, Vigilance and Anti-corruption Bureau, vide letter No: 23/cmp/SP(int)/2014 dtd - 15.11.2014 accorded sanction to register a Vigilance case against Shri. Rebul. R. Nair IPS, former District Police Chief Pathanamthitta District and Shri. Ajithkumar, a private person and middleman of Shri. Rebul. R. Nair u/s 7, 8, 13(1)(d) of PEA 1988.
