### ORDER

Government of India in the letter read above has informed that the problem of encroachments of forest land is assuming a serious proportion in the Country. These encroachments are seriously threatening the continuity of the Wild Life Corridors between various National Parks and Sanctuaries and timely action is not taken by frontline staff for the eviction of the encroachers which further emboldens others also for similar activities. It is also stated that the Hon'ble Supreme Court in their Order dated 23-11-2001 in IA No.703 in Pr. 202/95 have restrained the Central Government from regularisation of encroachment in the Country. Therefore, the Government of India have suggested time bound programme for eviction of encroachers from the forest land and steps to comply with the Hon'ble Supreme Court direction.

- 2. The Chief Conservator of Forests (Protection) in his letter read as 2nd paper above has also sent concrete proposals to Government seeking Government Orders for implementing the direction of the Government of India in compliance to the Hon'ble Supreme Court Orders.
- 3. As per Government Order 3rd read above, Government have ordered various measures to be taken in this regard, which include constitution of a State Level Monitoring Committee under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary for monitoring forest encroachments and review of remedial measures adopted.
- 4. Accordingly, Government are pleased to constitute a State Level Monitoring Committee, with the following members:-

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Ohs irman Chim Secretary Medice r Secretary (Forests) Member Secretary (Revenue) Secretary (Home) Hember Member Secretary (Law) Director General of Member Police. Principal Chief Conservator of Forests.. Director of Survey & Member Member Land Records. Chief Conservator of Forests in charge at Hember the Headquarters.

The Committee will meet biannually to take stock of the situation relating to encroachments. The Committee while Monitori forest encroachments should also fix responsibility of the field formulations including the Revenue Officials for their failure to prevent/evict encroachments on the forest lands.
