**ORDER**

In Budget 2010-11, an amount of ₹ 50 crore has been provided for implementing Income Support Scheme for Worker's of traditional sectors. It is proposed to implement the scheme for workers engaged in Fisheries, Coir, Khadi & Handloom sectors in the first phase.

The Income Support Scheme has been primarily meant for workers who have an annual income up to ₹ 25,000/- . The scheme is envisaged to ensure to get wages at least ₹ 150/- per day for minimum of 100 days in a year. The difference between ₹150/- and the actual wages earned per day will have to be paid to the workers from the sector.

As per the G.O. read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, Government have allotted ₹ 20 crore to the Khadi & Village Industries/Handloom Sector for implementation of the above scheme.

As per the G.O. read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above, Government have authorised the Labour Commissioner to allot the above amount of ₹ 20 crore to the Director of Industries & Commerce.

As per letter read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above, the Director, Handloom & Textiles has submitted the scheme to be introduced in the Handloom sector as detailed below:

1. The workers who are working under the Primary Handloom Co-operative Societies, Handloom clusters and consortiums approved by Development Commissioner for Handloom will get the benefit under this scheme.
2. The scheme aims to get rather better wages to the weavers/allied workers who earn only low wages.
3. The weavers who have been earning ₹ 50/- or above per day and allied workers earning ₹ 35/- or above per day only would come under the purview of this scheme.
4. The regular weavers/allied workers whose main source of income is from handloom sector only would be considered under this scheme.
5. The preliminary target fixed under this scheme is to get the workers ₹ 150/- per day as wages with the support of the scheme. The weaver/allied worker who earn above ₹ 150/- will not cover under this scheme.
6. The weaver/allied worker will get ₹ 75/-extra, in addition to his wage per day, if the clause 3 above is satisfied, subject to condition that the total wage plus extra assistance does not exceed ₹ 150/-. Further, the wage incentive shall be limited to ₹ 75/- per weaver/allied workers.
7. The maximum number of days to get the benefit under this scheme for a weaver/allied worker per year is 100 days.

8. The weavers who will be <sup>3</sup> considered under this scheme should have an average attendance of minimum 10 days in a calendar month. Those who are working under the weaving factories/common work sheds of primary handloom co-operative societies, Hantex and Hanveev, attendance of the weavers can be complied from the records of the institution. The weavers whose loom is housed with their residence, his/her attendance may be reckoned in accordance with the invoice register/production register of the primary handloom Co-operative Society, where he/she is attached with. The total wages he earns for the month divided by the total average man days of the month can be reckoned for computing wage per day and attendance, where monthly wages are paid. The attendance for the current month can be computed by dividing the total wage he earns during the month by the wage per day. The special wages is to be exempted from calculating the wage per day.
9. The General Manager, District Industries Centre shall collect the claim for each weaver/allied worker through the co-operative Inspector of the concerned handloom circle after necessary verification of the records of the institution and spot verification, if necessary. The details shall be collected by the District Industries centre by the 5<sup>th</sup> working day of each month and the eligible assistance shall be sanctioned and disbursed by the General Manager, District Industries Centre concerned. General Manager of the concerned District Industries centre shall open and operate separate bank account for this scheme. Eligible Weaver/allied workers shall open an SB account for this. The amount shall be transferred to the SB Account of the beneficiaries by the General Manager-DIC concerned.
10. No deduction such as EPF, ESI, CTF etc. shall be allowed on the amount paid/disbursed under this scheme.

11. Part time workers are not considered under this scheme. The weaving factories of Hantex and Hanveev will also be covered by the General Manager, District Industries Centre of the concerned district.

As per letter read as 5<sup>th</sup> paper above, the Secretary Khadi Board has reported that a scheme for implementing minimum wages has already been formulated for the Khadi Sector. Considering the request of various trade unions in the sector Government have appointed a Minimum Wages Committee for implementing minimum wages in the Khadi Sector. Government as per G.O. read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above have decided to implement minimum wages in the sector based on the study report submitted by the Minimum Wages Committee. But due to lack of funds this could not be implemented so far.

There are two classes in the Khadi Sector viz. Spinning & Weaving. Details of Khadi Workers and expected excess funds required for enhanced wages as requested by the Secretary, Khadi Board is given below:

**Spinning Sector**

(a)	Expected production in 2010-11	19695020 hanks
(b)	Wages to be paid as per existing Cost chart	₹ 5.18 crore
(c)	Minimum wages to be paid	₹ 11.18 crore
(d)	Excess amount required	6.00 crore

Incentive Scheme	
(a)	Wages to be paid at the minimum rate of ₹ 13.70 per day
(b)	Wages to be paid at the minimum rate of ₹ 13.70 per day
(c)	Minimum incentive amount of ₹ 13.70 per day
(d)	Maximum incentive amount of ₹ 13.70 per day

The Secretary, Khadi Board has requested for the implementation of minimum wages in the incentive scheme and sanction of funds to the tune of ₹ 13.70 crore.

Government have sanctioned the implementation of the above accord sanction for implementing the Incentive Scheme in the Handloom & Textile and Khadi Sectors and to allocate an amount of ₹ 10 crore (Rupees ten crore only) to each sector from the funds available to Khadi/Handloom Sectors as per the DDC, which are subject to the following conditions also:

1. The assistance on Incentive Support Scheme should be restricted to 150/- per day, and for 100 days/annum.
2. The maximum eligible wage by a worker will be ₹ 13.70 per day.
3. The maximum incentive amount will be double the wages that the worker is getting and the same should not exceed ₹ 13.70 per day.
4. The amount to implement the scheme for Khadi and Handloom Sectors will be placed at the disposal of Director of Industries & Commerce.
5. The General Managers of DIC will implement the same which comes under the Handloom Sector after preparing the eligibility list in consideration with Director of Handloom and Textiles.

6. The Secretary, Kerala Khadi & Village Industries Board, will implement the scheme which comes under Khadi Department of the Budget, Budget Cell of KKVIB, after preparing the necessary details.
