Public Works Department – NH 47 – Mannuthi - Edappalli Four Lane Road – Toll collection at Paliyakkara Toll Plaza - Concession on toll rate to local people and completion of allied works – Sanction accorded – orders issued:

<u>ORDER</u>

As part of the North – South Corridor (spur), The National Highway Authority of India prepared a Detailed Project Report during 2004-05 for the improvement of Mannuthi – Edappalli road in NH 47 and awarded the concession to Guruvayur Infrastructure Private Limited Company (Concessionaire). A State Support Agreement was executed by the State Government with the Central Government for the development of the National Highways in the State. As per the State Support Agreement the State Government have to give all support to the developmental activities of National Highways. As per the Concession Agreement between the NHAI and the Concessionaire, the concerned Concessionaire can collect toll at specified rate for 17 ½ years and a Toll Plaza was constructed at Paliyakkara in Mannuthi – Edappalli National Highway.

2. After getting Provisional Completion Certificate on 4.12.2011, the Concessionaire started toll collection on 5.12.2011. There was strong protest against the toll collection by local people and some organisations. They tried to demolish the Toll Plaza and ananhandled the employees. Due to the public protest, the Company could not continue to the toll collection. Thus a meeting was convened by the Hon. Chief Minister on 10.12.2011 at Ernakulam Government Guest House with people's representatives and other leaders. In the meeting, Chief Engineer (NH) was directed to prepare a detailed report on the remaining works to be completed as per the Concession Agreement within two week:

- 3. The Chief Engineer (NH) submitted a detailed report to Government as per second paper above. Based on the report, the Chief Minister and Minister for Works discussed the issues with people's representatives and leaders of other organisations on 14.1.2012, 19.1.2012, 23.1.2012, 30.1.2012 and 1.2.2012. In those discussions people's representatives requested to grant additional exemption and rebate on toll rates to local people. The details are given as Annexure I.
- 4. People's Representatives also requested to carry out the following additional works which were not included in the Detailed Project Report and Concession Agreement. (Annexure II)
- 5. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to issue orders as follows:
 - 1) The following works which were not included in the DPR and State Support Agreement shall be carried out additionally
 - a) Footpath on one side (1m width) to the newly constructed 7 bridges
 - b) Service road (27.6 km)
 - c) Flyovers / under passes (4 nos.)
 - d) Signal system (3 nos.)
 - e) Skywalks, wherever necessary (maximum 20 nos.)
 - 2) The Concessionaire Company should construct footpath to the newly constructed seven bridges in the Mannuthy Edappally stretch within seven days at their cost. After completing the works, they shall resume the toll collection.
 - 3) The work of newly proposed service roads (27.6 km) shall be completed within six months.
 - 4) The detailed estimate for the newly proposed service roads (27.6 km) shall be prepared by Project Director, National Highway Authority of India, Palakkad and the work should be executed immediately. Proposal for service roads should be recommended to NHAI for sanction. If NHAI does not provide funds for this works, Government of Kerala shall bear the expenditure.
 - 5) The expenditure for the additional concession on toll rate granted to local people are shown in Item No. 2 and 4 in Annexure I shall be met by Government of Kerala.
 - 6) The Project Director, National Highway Authority of India, Palakkad shall take urgent necessary action for the preparation of estimate and plans for constructing the flyovers/under passes mentioned in Annexure II and to get necessary approval from National Highway Authority of India.

7) The Project Director, National Highway Authority of India, Palakkad shall take urgent necessary action to prepare the detailed plan and estimate for the construction of skywalks wherever necessary (maximum 20 nos.) and arrange the work after getting approval from the State Government.
