ORDER

1) S/S Jiju B. Byju, Kumari. Anitha S and A. Sajitha Beevi, submitted a representation before Government on 09/05/2012 with a copy of the judgment in WP(C) No:14175/2007 jointly filed by them. In the judgment, the Hon'ble High Court directed that the representation shall be considered by the 1st respondent (Additional Chief Secretary, Higher Education Department) with notice to the petitioners, expeditiously, at any rate within a period of two months from the date of receipt of such representation. Till such time no fresh recruitment shall be effected against the posts held by the petitioners.

2) As such the petitioners were sent notice for the personal hearing at 11.00 am on 20.06.2012. Shri. Jiju B. Byju was absent Smt. Kumary Anitha was present and Smt.

Secretary (Rtd), Law Department as representative to attend the hearing. The Director, Kerala State Science and Technology Museum, has authorised Sri. C.R.Satheesh Chandran the Accounts Officer and Smt. Binu E, U.D Clerk for attending the hearing.

3) The gist of the case is as follows:

The second respondent, ie, Director, KSSTM issued Ext.P1 notification No.B/1153/2003 dated 02.06.2003 and Ext.P1(a) advertisement in Mathrubhoomi daily dated 06.06.2003 inviting applications for appointment against various posts in the Kerala State Science & Technology Museum, Thiruvananthapuram. The petitioners responded to the said notification. After due process of selection, they were included in the rank list. Subsequently the petitioners were appointed into its service as per Exts.P5 to P7. They would reveal that the petitioners were appointed respectively as Workshop Attender, L.D.Typist and Receptionist. Consequently, they joined in their respective posts. According to the petitioners, respondents 3 to 8 had also joined its service pursuant to the said selection and they are still continuing in service. It is the case of the petitioners that after their joining in the service, Government, vide Ext.P9, called for specific proposals on regularisation of employees under the second respondent. Meanwhile, the petitioners were admitted into Employees Provident Fund. Again, Government issued Expt.P10 dated 13.12.2005 in the matter of regularisation of the petitioners and others. The Governing Body of the Museum, then, took the decision to ratify the appointments of the petitioners as is obvious from Ext.P11. According to them, despite the ratification by the Governing Body, the Director, the second respondent, refused to issue formal orders regularising their services and, at the same time, took steps to terminate their services.

it was in the said circumstances that they were constrained to approach the Government through Ext.P12. As already noticed, pursuant to the order of the Hon'ble High Court dated 02.05.2007, the petitioners were heard on Ext.P12 and thereafter, the first respondent passed Ext.P14 order on Ext.P12. In terms of the directions in Ext.P14, the second respondent issued Ext.P15 order terminating the services of the petitioners.

4) In the hearing held on 20-06-2012 the representative of Smt. A. Sajitha Beevi argued that due to the following grounds she is entitled to get in to the service of Kerala State Science and Technology Museum

- i. The petitioner has applied to the post of Receptionist as per the Notification dated 02.06.2003 and she possessed all the required qualifications.
 - ii. There was no change in the qualification prescribed for the post in the special Rules framed. As per the qualification in the special Rules framed, the petitioner possesses the required qualification.
 - iii. The petitioner was working in the Museum since 22.11.1994 as a daily waged employee till she joined duty as Receptionist as per the appointment order dated 23.02.2004.
 - iv. The Petitioner is entitled to get the benefit of age relaxation since the Executive Committee meeting held on 14.07.2003 have resolved to relax the upper age limit to 40 years to those who are working on daily wages at the time of Notification. The Governing Body of KSSTM had ratified the above decision. The intention behind the relaxation of age limit to 40 years was to provide an opportunity to the daily waged employees working in the Museum at the time of Notification.
 - v. The petitioner was working as daily waged employee at

the time of issuance of the notification.

- vi. It is evident that there is no justifiable reason to review the appointment of the petitioner as Receptionist since there is no procedural irregularity in the matter of selection to the post.
- vii. The petitioner was the 1st rank holder in the interview and therefore she alone is legally entitled to get appointment, and the rank list of candidates to the post was published on 31.01.2004. She was provisionally appointed as Receptionist and joined duty on 27.02.2004.
- viii. Since the KSSTM being an autonomous body, the administration of the Museum is vested with the Executive Committee and Governing Body. The Executive Committee has the power to relax the age limit on reasonable grounds and the Governing Body have ratified the same.
- ix. The Governing Body of the Museum took the decision to ratify the appointment of the petitioner. Despite the ratification by the Governing Body, the Director refused to issue formal orders regularising her service and at the same time took steps to terminate her service.
- x. The petitioner was appointed into the service of the Museum on regular basis pursuant to a proper notification and a selection process. She was not a back door entrant and the Governing Body had taken a decision to ratify her appointment.
- xi. The post of Receptionist is now vacant since the Hon'ble High Court has stayed of all further proceedings of the 2nd respondent (Director) to fill up the vacancy of Receptionist and the stay was extended from time to time.

5) The Hon.High Court has observed that the first and second respondent could have gone into the matter of the selection at the time of appointment and once the appointment is effected and ratified they could not have and should not have altered the decision of the selection committee. The petitioner has not misrepresented for getting any undue advantage and the selection committee had granted the relaxation. In view of the decision of Hon'ble Apex court reported in 2006 (5) SCC 96, the doctrine of relation back is applicable in the case of the 3rd petitioner.

The petitioner was appointed as Receptionist under the 2nd respondent in the early part of 2004 and continued in service till she was terminated from service dated 21.07.2007. In other words she had put in more than three years of service under the second respondent on the strength of the appointment order. Through Government have specifically directed for issuing notice to the petitioner in Ext.P.14. She was not put on notice and not provided with an opportunity of being heard or to make representation before termination of her service as per Ext.P.15. Evidently Ext.P.14 did not specifically direct the second respondent to terminate the service of the petitioner forthwith and infact directed the respondent to put the petitioner on notice. Hence the second respondent was under an obligation to issue notice to the petitioner before terminating her service.

6) In the hearing Smt Kumari Anitha had contented that at the time of her termination she had put in more than three years of service under the second respondent. It is also noted that the counter affidavits did not state what exactly was the length of my actual experience that was taken into account. Government have specifically directed for issuing notice to the petitioners in Ext.P.14 no such procedure has not been followed in this case. Therefore the whole matter requires serious consideration by Government and for such consideration, it is submitted that the Hon'ble

High Court set aside the Ex.P14 and P15 and confirmed and made clear in the judgment the right of the petitioners to get re-inducted into service and get consequential benefits, as the Hon'ble High Court stayed the fresh selection and no prejudice would be carried in considering my claims I have already submitted a representation dated 08.05.2012 along with other petitioners as directed by the Hon'ble High Court. Therefore your gracious authority may consider the pathetic situation of the humble petitioner and request your kindness for mitigating my grievance and I may be reinducted in Service on the light of the Judgment dated 13.04.2012 of the Hon'ble High Court in W.P.(C) 14175/07 filed by me and two others.

7) It is clear that as per the MOA the Governing Body has powers to create certain posts. The selection committee has decided to relax the qualification prescribed by the Kerala State Science and Technology Museum in the notification dated 02.06.2003 and selected three candidates. After the decision of the selection committee, the appointments were made by the Director in January/February 2004. The matter was taken up in the Governing Body meeting only on 01.03.2006. The Governing Body also ratified the decision of the selection committee. Rule 3(C) of KS&SSR is binding on all appointments in public service and appointments can be terminated if any irregularity in appointments is found within a period of one year from the date of appointment. In this case neither the appointing authority nor the Government have found any irregularities But among the selected list of posts only the three members were terminated and others were allowed to continue as employees of Kerala State Science and Technology Museum.

8) Having examined all the relevant details provided by the petitioners at the time of hearing and as per the

records, Smt.A Sajitha Beevi and Smt.Kumari Anitha is entitled for
action in the service of KSSTM as Receptionist and Typist respectively.
Director has reported that Sri.Jiju B Byju was got appointment in Police
Department as Constable. There for his case was not considered.

9) In the above circumstances and in due compliance of the Hon'ble High
Court judgement in WP(C)No:14175/07 Government are pleased to order that
Smt.A.Sajitha Beevi is re-inducted into the service of KSSTM as Receptionist
in the existing vaccancy and Kumari.Anitha S is also re-inducted as Typist in
the KSSTM by converting one post of Peon/Attender as L.D. Typist.

10)The Director, KSSTM is directed to issue posting orders to the
incumbents forthwith and report compliance to Government.
