





1. The travel and tourism industry has emerged as one of the fastest growing sectors contributing significantly to the economic growth and development of Kerala. Recently District Tourism Promotion Council, Ernakulam has gone forward with the development of new destinations in the district apart from famous and already developed major tourism spots.
2. District Tourism Promotion Council developed Kadambayar Boat club and restaurant as a tourism project on the banks of river Kadambayar. 





Kumbalam is a region in the urban agglomeration of Kochi, bound by the Vembanad Lake, as well as the fast encroaching city of Kochi. Kumbalam is progressively being transformed into an urban region, becoming part of the city. In local administration, Kumbalam is yearning to be dissolved into the Corporation of Kochi in steps.

Director, Department of Tourism has submitted a proposal for the Development of Walkway at Kumbalam, Ernakulam at an estimated cost of Rs. 1,49,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore Forty Nine Lakhs only) including the components of Landscaped Walkway, Fountain, Fountains, Children Play Area, Ticket Counter, Toilets, Electrification & lighting and Plumbing & other allied works. 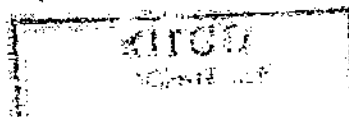
