2. Circular No.93/2018/Fin dated 15.10.2018.

Government had issued detailed guidelines to all Administrative Departments for undertaking 20% plan cut in their state plan schemes and re-prioritisation exercise for remaining 80% state plan schemes in the aftermath of the recent devastating floods in Kerala as per Government order read above. Accordingly, Administrative Departments reported the amount of 20% plan cut after effecting plan cut in the budget allocation of their plan schemes.

Government, after having examined the matter in detail, are pleased to issue department-wise 20% plan cut amount as Annexure - I to this Government order. In this regard, the following further instructions are issued for urgent compliance:-

1)The Administrative Department should issue revised Administrative Sanction for the schemes which need to be cancelled/dropped completely or partially consequent on the 20% plan cut. This cut should be based on the

proposals given by the departments to Finance Department vide Government order read as 1st above. If Administrative Sanction has already been issued for such schemes, it should be revised suitably or cancelled so as to ensure that 20% plan cut is made in the allocation of such plan schemes.

2)In the case of departments that did not report the details of plan cut within the stipulated time limit, 20% cut is effected in all plan schemes of such departments and appended as Annexure – II to this Government order.




