
Sir,

I am directed to refer to the State Government's letter FC2/63200/2018 dated 13.12.2018 on above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and to say that the proposal has been examined by the Forest Advisory Committee constituted by the Central Government under Section-3 of the said Act.

After careful examination of the proposal of the State Government and on the basis of the recommendations of the Forest Advisory Committee, the one time permission of the Central Government under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 is hereby granted for removal of Sand and Silt accumulated at Pampa-Thrivani near Sabrimala, Kerala State subject to the following conditions:


- (i) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land;
- (ii) No NPV and cost towards CA shall be levied.
- (iii) During the removal, utmost care should be taken so that no damage to flora and fauna is caused.
- (iv) The User Agency shall obtain the Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if required;
- (v) The User Agency shall provide fuels preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.
- (vi) No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused;
- (vii) No tree felling shall be done;
- (viii) Any other condition that the concerned Regional Office of this Ministry may stipulate with the approval of competent authority in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife; and
- (ix) The User Agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.

ORDER

As per the Government Order read 1st paper above, Government accorded permission for the following:-

a. Permitting transport of sand required for sale to own-use customers, from Pamba - Thriveni to the dumping sites at the forest periphery at Laha before the onset of monsoon.

b. Allotting sand to TDB on their request, at seignorage rate, for their construction at Nilakkal Base Camp.

c. Sale of sand to the own use customers through e-auction, with quantity restriction of 1- 10 M3. About 15,000 M3 of sand is earmarked for this mode of disposal.

d. Sale of sand to bulk customers, of lot size of 1000 M3 each, through e-auction platform of the Kerala Forest Department. The quantity of sand available after sale to own use customers and allotting to TDB is earmarked for this.

2. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forest [Forest, Land & Resources], as per the letter read 2nd paper above has reported that, the Kerala Forest Department tried for the bulk sale through e-auction on 07/03/2019 and 20/03/2019 for 55 lots with a lot size of 1000 m³/lot, keeping the seignorage rate of Rs. 2777/m³ as the STA price (subject to Approval Price). No one participated in the auction on

07/03/2019. On 20/03/2019 even though two bidders remitted EMD for the e-auction, they did not quote any rate. Hence, the auctions were not successful. Therefore, he has requested to issue orders allowing the Forest Department to conduct the e-auction sale of sand to bulk customers on the basis of the DSR 2016 rate of Rs. 1200/m³. Also requested to adopt the above DSR 2016 rate of Rs. 1200/m³ along with transportation charges in the e-auction retail sales to the own-use customers also.

3. Government have examined that matter in detail in the circumstances reported by the the Principal Chief Conservator of Forest [Forest, Land & Resources], and are pleased to accord sanction to the Forest Department to conduct e-auction sale of sand accumulated at Pamba-Thriveni after giving wide publicity, to bulk customers by adopting Central PWD's DSR rate @ 1200/m³, now being followed by the state PWD. Sanction is also accorded to adopt the above DSR rate @ 1200/m³, along with transportation charges in the e-auction retail sales to the own-use customers also.

4. The Chief Secretary is authorised to make appropriate changes in this arrangement, if found necessary.

ORDER

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Head of Forest Forces as per the letter read 1st paper above reported that, as per the assessment made by the the Forest Department, the sand accumulated at Pampa is about 90,000m³, out of which 20,000m³ of sand has been tentatively earmarked to Travancore Devaswam Board for the development of Base Camp at Nilakkal, 15,000 m³ for sale to own-use customers (retail sale) through e-auction and 55,000 m³ for bulk customers through e-auction platform. It was also informed that, if interested, Travancore Devaswom Board can remove the sand by remitting the seigniorage rate of Rs. 2777/m³, Forest Development Tax (5%), GST (5%) and royalty (Rs. 88/-) etc.

2. As per the Government Order read 2nd paper above, Government have accorded permission for the following:-

a. Permitting transport of sand required for sale to own use customers, from Pamba -Thriveni to the dumping sites at the forest periphery at Laha before the onset of monsoon.

b. Allotting sand to TDB on their request, at seigniorage rate, for their construction at Nilakkal Base Camp.

c. Sale of sand to the own use customers through e-auction, with quantity

restriction of 1- 10 M3. About 15,000 M3 of sand is earmarked for this mode of disposal.

d. Sale of sand to bulk customers, of lot size of 1000 M3 each, through e-auction platform of the Kerala Forest Department. The quantity of sand available after sale to own use customers and allotting to TDB is earmarked for this.

3. The Secretary, Travancore Devaswom Board vide letter read 4th paper above has requested to allot the sand free of cost and to permit them to use the same as per their requirement by keeping it in the current places at Pamba.

4. Government as per the Order read 6th paper above, have directed the Travancore Devaswom Board to remove 20,000m³ (Twenty thousand cubic meters) of sand from the sand accumulated at Pamba-Thriveni immediately, in view of the impending monsoon, subject to the condition that the orders regarding the rate of the sand allotted will be issued separately.

5. Government have examined the request of the Travancore Devaswom Board in detail and are pleased to accord sanction for treating the 20,000m³ of sand allotted to them as per the Government Order read as 6th above, as free of cost.


