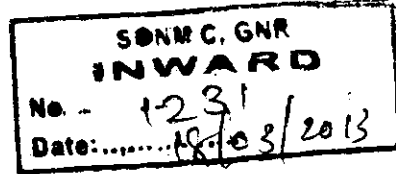

ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above permission has been granted to establish a Medical College at Idukki in Idukki District. Vide Government Order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, the Project Management for establishment of this new Medical College has been entrusted with M/s KITCO Limited. As per letter read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above, the Special Officer for New Medical Colleges has submitted the estimate report amounting to ₹.6,25,01,410 (Rupees Six Crores Twenty Five Lakhs One thousand Four Hundred and Ten only) prepared by M/s KITCO Limited for according administrative sanction for the Phase I construction of new Government Medical College at Idukki by meeting the expenditure under the head of account "4210-03-105-66 (P)".

2. The Special Working Group under the Chairmanship of Principal Secretary to Government (Finance) in its meeting held on 01.03.2013 approved the proposal for phase I construction of new Government Medical College, Idukki at a total cost of ₹ 6.25 Crore (Rupees Six Crore and Twenty Five lakh only) by meeting the expenditure under the head of account "4210-03-105-66 (P)".

3. On the recommendation of the Special Working Group, Government are pleased to accord administrative sanction for phase I construction of new Government Medical College, Idukki at a total cost of ₹.6,25,01,410 (Rupees Six Crores Twenty Five Lakhs One thousand Four Hundred and Ten only) by meeting the expenditure under the head of account "4210-03-105-66 (P)", subject to the following conditions :-

1. The Store Purchase Rules shall be strictly adhered to.
2. Public Works Department Schedule of Rates shall be followed at every stage of work.
3. Tender and other stipulated formalities shall be followed wherever necessary.
4. The release of fund will be based on actual requirement and released amount should not be parked in the bank.

20% of the project cost will be sanctioned as an advance to M/s KITCO Limited, before the commencement of the project. Subsequent payment will be released on a monthly basis on reimbursement of paid Running Account bills to Contractor/Supplier.

The Special Officer for new Medical Colleges will monitor the works.

- I. Setup 500 Bedded Hospital
- II. Expecting annual intake of 100 MBBS students
- III. To create facilities for Para clinical subjects.

The Senior Consultant, M/s KITCO Limited, Kochi will move Government in the Finance Department through Health and Family Welfare Department for release of funds at the appropriate time based on actual necessity, supported by the progress of construction work. The Senior Consultant, M/s KITCO Limited, Kochi and the Special Officer for New Medical Colleges will ensure release of funds at the appropriate time and that the construction work is completed before March 2014 as per the Public Works Department schedule of rates 2012.

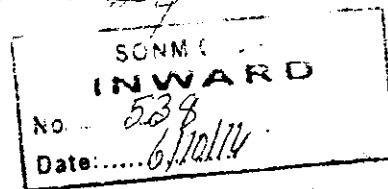
