## FOURTEENTH KERALA LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY SEVENTEENTH SESSION

Resolution passed unanimously in the Legislative Assembly on 31<sup>st</sup>

December, 2019

The Constitution 126<sup>th</sup> Amendment Bill passed by both Houses of the Parliament provides for extending reservation to the Scheduled Caste - Scheduled Tribe communities in the Lok Sabha and State Legislative Assemblies for further ten years. In the Bill reservation is provided to be continued till 25<sup>th</sup> January, 2030. But in the Constitution 126<sup>th</sup> Amendment Bill, no provision is made for extension of the period of representation of Anglo-Indian Communities in the Lok Sabha and State Legislative Assemblies for 10 more years which expires on 26<sup>th</sup> January, 2020, under Article 334(b) of the Constitution.

The Kerala Legislative Assembly requests the Central Government to take urgent steps for necessary amendment of the Constitution for continuing the representation which is available to the Anglo Indian Community in the country so far.
