എ) പോലീസിന് അനുവദിക്കുന്ന നവീകരണ ഫണ്ടിൽ ഡി.ജി.പി.ക്ക് ഉപയോഗിക്കാവുന്ന തുകയുടെ പരിധി എത്രയാണെന്ന് വ്യക്തമാക്കുമോ;

എ) കേന്ദ്ര സർക്കാരിന്റെ MoPF സ്കീമിൽ, സംസ്ഥാന പോലീസ് മേധാവിക്ക് ഉപയോഗിക്കാവുന്ന തുകയുടെ പരിധി ഇപ്പോൾ 5 കോടി രൂപയാണ്.

ബി) പ്രസ്തുത തുകയുടെ പരിധി കഴിഞ്ഞവർഷം വരെ എത്രയായിരുന്നുവെന്നും നിലവിൽ ഇതിന്റെ പരിധി ഉയർത്തിയിട്ടുണ്ടോ എന്നതിന്റെയും വിശദവിവരം നൽകുമോ;

ബി) MoPF സ്കീമിൽ 04.07.2015 ലെ ജി.ഒ. (ആർ.ടി) നം. 1658/2015/ആഭ്യന്തരം നമ്പർ ഉത്തരവ് പ്രകാരം നിശ്ചയിക്കപ്പെട്ട പ്രകാരം തുകയുടെ പരിധി 2 കോടിയായിരുന്നു. 18.01.2020 തീയതിയിലെ സ.ഉ. (സാധാ) നം. 185/2020/ആഭ്യന്തരം പ്രകാരം അധികാരപരിധി 5 കോടി രൂപയായി ഉയർത്തിയിട്ടുണ്ട്.

Kind attention is invited to the subject and references cited above.

02.A proposal for the enhancement of delegation of financial power of the DGP & State Police Chief from Rs. 2 Crore to Rs.5 Crore regarding MoPF Scheme was sent to the Government, vide reference cited 1st dated 20.04.2018. But, as per reference cited 3rd dated 08.06.2019, the Government rejected the proposal. Another letter, vide reference cited 1st dated 14.06.2019, was sent to the Government clarifying the need of the enhancement in delegation of power of the State Police Chief and its future implication on acquiring incentives from the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) for MoPF Schemes. Also as per reference cited 2nd, it was requested to enhance the delegation of financial power of the DGP & State Police Chief and his subordinate officers in the manner Rs. 10 Crore for DGP & State Police Chief, Rs. 5 Crore for ADGP, Rs. 3 Crore for IGP, Rs. 2 Crore for DIG and Rs. 1 Crore



for AAIG.

03.In light of the above, as desired by the Government, vide reference cited 3rd dated 06.07.2019, the clarification for enhancing the delegation of financial powers for the DGP & his Subordinate Officers for MoPF Scheme is furnished below:

04.As per reference cited 4th above, the Ministry of Home Affairs had enhanced the delegation of financial powers for various items/budget heads to the Director Generals/Director of CAPFs/NSG/IB/NIA and streamlined the procurement process. Accordingly, the same was forwarded to this department from MHA, vide reference cited 5th and recommended to adopt similar measure for the State Police Forces also. For example, for the purchase of computer and peripherals, the Director General/Special Director General is given a delegation of Rs.5 Crore in CAPF and for machinery & equipments Rs.20 Crore. As MHA has directed to enhance the delegation of the officers in this manner, including the current financial delegation the DGP and his Subordinate Officers for MoPF Schemes so as to help the department to acquire and utilize the funds from Ministry of Home Affairs more effectively.

05.Also, as per reference cited 6th, the Ministry of Home Affairs has directed to furnish the 'Self-Evaluation for Reporting Progress on Reform Implementation' for grant of incentives (Rs 158.26 Crore) for Police reform during the year 2019-20 under the scheme of 'Assistance to States for Modernization of Police'. In the letter the Ministry of Home Affairs has informed that the evaluation of the States shall be done only based on some criteria. **In Point No. 'V (V)', it is noted that reforms on the basis of implementation of the "Delegation of adequate financial powers to Director Generals/Commissioner of Police" is a criteria for granting incentives.** It is given a score of 10 for BPR & D Assessment. Only those States achieving 70% and above overall reform score will be considered for incentives.

06.Hence, in a nutshell, if the delegation of the Director General of Police and other higher officers are not enhanced, then the score for Kerala Police will decrease drastically as it alone has a total of 10 points. If such an instance occurs and if the department cannot score above 70%, then we will lose our incentives from MHA. Without the funds from MHA the reforms and developments in the department cannot move forward, which will affect the total functioning of the department itself. Not to mention the burden it will put on the State Government which will also be huge as the department would have to depend entirely and only on the State Government for the funds.

07.It may also be noted that the last date of receipt of 'Self Evaluation Report' in the Ministry is 10th January, 2020 and UCs, as on 31.12.2019, received till 10th January, 2020 will also be taken into account for considering eligibility of the States for the incentives. Hence, the delegation of the Director General of Police and his subordinate officers has to be enhanced urgently as it could take time to prepare the report for MHA, covering all the aspects called for by the Ministry of Home Affairs. Any delay in the matter would cost the department huge loss of funds.



08. In these circumstances, it is requested to kindly consider the grave seriousness of the matter and issue necessary Govt. orders enhancing the delegation of the Director General of Police & State Police Chief and subordinate officers for the MoPF Schemes as follows:

1. DGP - Rs.10 Crore.
2. ADGP - Rs.5 Crore.
3. IGP - Rs.3 Crore.
4. DIG - Rs.2 Crore.
5. AAIG - Rs.1 Crore.

Early orders are solicited in this matter.


