ORDER

The Co - ordination Committee in its meeting held on 16th September 2015 decided to implement safe and Animal friendly Environment, Kerala Project (SAFE KERALA PROJECT). As per the decision the most important step towards controlling the dog menace is to implement the Licensing rule strictly. Separate orders are being issued for this.

The Animal Husbandary Department is planning to have a massive vaccination and sterilization programme with the active participation of Local Government Institutions. All dogs including pet dogs shall be vaccinated, sterilized and marked (with a notch on the ear lobe). The willing owners may get their pets sterilized. There will be vaccination and certification for dogs reared by breeders as well. The Animal Husbandry Department upgraded 50 Poly Clinics at Taluk Head Quarters level for the purpose of conducting sterilizations. They will upgrade the balance 25 Taluk level Polyclinics also. In Blocks where Polielinics are not located, Animal Husbandry Department will upgrade the block head quarters level Veterinary Hospitals /Clinics so that all blocks will have facilities. The Panchayath level Veterinary Clinics also will undertake sterilization where ever feasible.

In view of the above decision, Government are pleased to order that the Animal Husbandry Department will take care of the technical aspects and the Local Government will take care of the Logistic part of the programme. The Local Self Governments should make arrangements for capturing the stray dogs; transporting them to the block level centre for intervention and transferring them after the intervention to the location from which the dogs were captured. The Local Governments have to incur an expenditure of about Rs 250/- per dog. An incentive of Rs.250/- per dogs sterilized may also be given in regards to pet dogs on production of certificate issued by a Veterinary Surgeon by the owner. The Local Governments should take steps to invite Quotations for engaging dog catchers, with Rs. 250/- per dog as the upper limit. The public awareness creation and public participation also are to be ensured by the Local Governments

Government also order as the follows;

- (1) Local Governments (Grama Panchayath and Urban bodies) are allowed to prepare projects for the control of Dog menace using plan funds as envisioned above and implement it pending approval by DPC for the variation.
- (2) District Panchayaths are allowed to continue the Schemes being under taken in convergence with the Scheme.
- (3) Local Governments are allowed to call Quotations for the purpose of capturing, transporting and re transporting stray dogs on 22nd September giving time up to 29th and finalize it on 29th itself.
- (4) The Local Governments are directed to start Campaign on 1st October 2015.
- (5) The District Collectors may review the progress of the campaign periodically and apprise the Government on the progress.



CIRCULAR

Sub - LSGD – Stray dog menace – Comprehensive Action Plan – Instructions issued -reg.

Ref- Minutes of the meeting chaired by the Hon'ble Chief Minister on 22/08/2016

On the basis of the decision taken in the meeting held on 22.08.2016 to design and implement a Comprehensive Action Plan to control the menace of stray dogs, the following instructions are issued.

1. The District Collectors and District Panchayats will lead the campaign. In the first phase, a data base will be created through desk exercise, mainly from local reports and from the media till the 21st August, 2016 on dog bites, observed data on the presence of pack of dogs, proximity to unauthorised slaughterhouses, waste dumps etc. The vulnerable geographical areas where immediate action is required, panchayat wise, shall be identified in a week.
2. The Director of Panchayaths & Director of Urban Affairs will prepare a model project for Grama Panchayats, Block Panchayats, Urban Local Bodies and District Panchayats in the pattern of Palakkad project. The transportation of dogs to the dog park in phase 1 and running of block level dog immunization camps at the block level in phase 2 of the campaign shall be met from the funds pooled through these projects at the district level.
3. The skilled dog catchers in the district shall be enrolled and enough number of catchers skilled through ToTs by mobilizing relevant agencies. The District Collectors will coordinate and the Secretary of every Local Government will ensure mobilized, required skilled people
4. The Secretary, Agriculture department will urgently notify two to three acres of land inside the agricultural farms under district panchayat and enclosed with temporary fencing, to be maintained as a stray dog rehabilitation zoo.
5. The animal welfare agencies in the district who are willing to manage the SDZ shall be registered and the zone management may be entrusted to them. The

- responsibility shall include sterilisation, anti rabies vaccination, fixing of a RFD collar, deworming, feeding the animal for five days, offering the animal for adoption and certifying that it is safe to release the animal back into the street as per law. The Secretaries of local Governments will coordinate this activity at their respective jurisdiction as directed by the District Collectors.
6. The local body in charge of area identified in (1) above, shall use the enrolled dog catchers in (3) above and bring the captured dogs to the dog zoo using vehicles hired for the purpose.
 7. The amount required for the activity will be used from plan/own funds and also through voluntary contributions from Residents Associations, CSR, and potential resources from AWBI etc.
 8. The above activities at phase 1 shall commence with effect from September 1, 2016.
 9. In phase 2, stray dog immunization camps will be held in all Block Panchayats, every two days in a week. Animal husbandry department shall make available qualified veterinary doctors for the immunization camp. All immunized/sterilised dogs shall be fitted with an RFID collar.
 10. Continuous weekly monitoring of the progress of ABC programme will be done by one Joint Director of Panchayats and one Joint Director of Urban Local Bodies and details will be published in the website and reported to District Collectors for consolidation and submission to Government.
 11. Initial resources will be mobilized from own funds and plan funds of Local Self Government Institutions. The Animal Husbandry Department will make available sufficient number of Veterinary Doctors on contract to Local Self Government Institutions to carry out ABC programme where there is shortage of Veterinary Doctors at present.
 12. Even the possibility of final year students of BVSc course may be explored for this purpose.
 13. Simultaneously a campaign to ensure strong punitive action against dumping of slaughter waste and food waste shall be taken up by the local bodies. They will discharge their mandatory responsibility of scientific management of solid and liquid waste, with special focus on meat waste and enforce the Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 read with the provisions of the Panchayat and Municipality Acts.
 14. A pet policy shall be drawn up which will ensure that every dog owner is licensed and registered by local governments and a fee be charged that can cross subsidise the cost of continuing stray dog menace.

15. Vehicles for transporting dogs shall be hired. Hiring charges and remuneration of dog catchers shall be fixed by the District Level Committee chaired by the District Collectors.


