

An amount of Rs.40.12 Crore was allotted to the Fire & Rescue Services Department in the State Annual Plan for the financial year 2017-18 under the Head of Account 2070-OAS-108- Fire Protection & Control, 94 - Modernisation of Fire & Rescue services Department -(P) for the purchase of life saving equipments and vehicles. As per the Government order read as first paper above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for Rupees 10 Crore for the purchase of 25 numbers of Mini Water tenders, which was included in the Green Book.

2. The Director General, Fire & Rescue Services, as per the letter read as 2nd paper above has submitted a comprehensive proposal for the purchase of vehicles and equipments and other components with a total project cost of Rs.3012 Lakh (Rupees Three Thousand Twelve Lakh Only) and requested to issue Administrative Sanction for the same.
