Sir,

I am directed to refer to the project proposal submitted by Director (Tourism), Government of Kerala vide letter no P3-9335/2016 dated: 03.03.2017 and to convey the sanction of the President of India for Development at Guruvayur Temple under the PRASAD Scheme for a total cost of Rs. 4614.20/- lakh (Rupees forty six crore fourteen lakh and twenty thousand only) as per the plans and estimates submitted along with the aforesaid letter.

2. Details of the facilities to be provided/established under the PRASAD Scheme are as under:

3. The sanction of the President is also accorded for release of Rs.922.84/- lakh (Rupees nine crore twenty two lakh eighty four thousand only) as first installment (being 20% of CFA) in advance in favour of Kerala Tourism Infrastructure Limited, Government of Kerala for the aforesaid sanctioned work.

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4. The payment will be arranged by Drawing and Disbursing Officer of the Ministry of Tourism by presenting a bill to Pay & Accounts Officer, Ministry of Tourism for electronic transfer of funds in favour of Kerala Tourism Infrastructure Limited (KTIL), Government of Kerala, Bank name & address- State Bank of Travancore, Vazhuthacaud, P.B. NO.409, T.N Towers, TC 13/1688(3), Thycaud P.O., Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala, PIN-695014. Bank Account No.0200067365475133, MICR Code 695009030, IFSC Code SBTR0000053.
5. Principal Secretary (Tourism), Govt. of Kerala will be the Nodal Officer for implementation and monitoring of the project.
6. The State Govt. of Kerala shall make the land available for the project free of cost and also render all assistance for completion of the project on time. No portion of the sanctioned project should be executed/ implemented on land/ property owned by private individual or trust.
7. The Kerala Tourism Infrastructure Limited, the implementing agency would execute the work and shall have the work started immediately to ensure timely utilization of funds and to avoid escalation on account of delay etc. The project should be completed in 24 months and any cost escalation on account of delay etc. would be met by the State Government and no reimbursement will be made by the Central Government on this account. The 2nd installment being 30% of the project cost will be released on receipt of utilization certificate of the first installment and 3rd installment of 30% will be released on receipt of utilization certificate of the second installment and 4th & final installment of 20% will be released in the form of reimbursement on completion of the project work and receipt of utilization certificate/ completion certificate to the effect that the project has been completed as per original plan, drawing & design, blue print etc. as approved by the Central Government.
8. The State Government / Kerala Tourism Infrastructure Limited shall have to follow all legal formalities while implementing the project, Management Agreement for proper upkeep, maintenance and operation of the assets created and undertaking that the facility and the land on which the project has been constructed out of CFA will not be transferred/sold/alienated without approval of the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India.
9. The State Government has ensured that there is no duplication of components under any other scheme/ funding agreement being made for the project.
10. The State Government/ Kerala Tourism Infrastructure Limited shall form a Monitoring Committee for the purpose of providing feedback of the physical and financial progress of the sanctioned project and submit the progress report on monthly basis to Ministry of Tourism.
11. The executing agency shall put in place the mandatory facilities for barrier free access by physically disabled persons.
12. The funds will be utilized only for the purpose for which they are released. The State Government shall not rent/lease or transfer the property without the permission of the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India.
