

ORDER

The Hon'ble Supreme Court appointed a Committee to decide on the compensation to be awarded to the victims of stray dog menace in Kerala with Justice(Rtd.) Siri Jagan as Chairman with the Law Secretary and the Director of Health Services as members. The Committee submitted its 3rd report to the Hon'ble Supreme Court, recommending a total amount of Rs. 33,37,743/- as compensation to 19 claimants. The Hon'ble Court accepted the report and ordered to pay the compensation to the victims within a time frame.

2. On the basis of the judgement read as 1st paper above, the Chief Secretary conducted a meeting on 03.05.2017 to sort out the issues related to the implementation of the Judgement and it was decided to implement the direction of the Hon'ble Court within the time limit as directed, as read as 2nd paper above.

3. In the above circumstances, sanction is accorded to the Secretaries of the Local Bodies concerned to pay the compensation awarded by the Committee to the claimants as per order read as 1st paper above, as detailed below, from the Own fund or Plan Fund(Service Sector) of the Local Bodies concerned before 31.05.2017. A copy of the relevant version of the Supreme Court Judgement is also enclosed.

ORDER

The Hon: Supreme Court appointed Justice(Rtd.) Siri Jagan Committee to decide on the compensation to be awarded to the victims of Stray Dog Menace in Kerala. The Committee submitted 9 reports before Hon'ble Court. Based on the judgement read as 1st above, compensations to the claimants included in the 3rd report were disbursed as per the Government Order read as 2nd above. The Hon: Court accepted the reports from 4 to 9 also and ordered to file a response to the same. Accordingly, Government filed a response, praying to limit the maximum amount of compensation as Rs. 5 lakh in a single case and to withhold compensation in two claims (claim No. 51 and claim no. 250). Claim No. 51 as per Report No. 6, related to an incident took place in 1983 but further legal proceeding initiated by the claimant were dismissed. Later the Hon: High Court dismissed his claim for compensation but allowed all allied treatment of the petitioner free of cost. Claim No 250 in Report No.7, is in respect of unfortunate death of the victim due to the negligence on the part of doctors in treating the victim. Hence the compensations in claim No. 51 and claim No. 250 are withheld,

2. In compliance to the judgement of the Hon: Supreme Court read 3rd above, sanction is accorded to Secretaries of the Local Bodies concerned to pay the compensations awarded to the claimants included in the 4th to 9th reports of the

Committee immediately as detailed below, from the Own Fund or Plan Fund (Service Sector) of the Local Bodies concerned;

ORDER

In the Judgement read as 1st paper above the Hon: Supreme Court, directed the Government, to file a response upon the reports (No. 4 to 9) of the Justice (Rtd) Sirijagan Committee. Accordingly Government filed a response, praying to limit the maximum amount of compensation as Rs. 5 lakh in a single case as the disbursement of huge compensations, recommended by the Committee, cause heavy financial burden on the Local Self Government bodies. As per the Government Order read as 2nd paper above, sanction was accorded by Government to the Local Bodies concerned for the disbursement of compensation amount to the claimants in the 4th to 9th reports of Justice (Rtd) Sirijagan Committee, limiting the maximum amount of compensation as Rs. 5 lakh.

2) Sri. Jose Sebastian, a claimant in the 5th report of the committee and husband of the deceased stray dog victim Dolly, filed contempt petition (civil) No. 944 /2017 alleging non receipt of the compensation amount as recommended by Justic(Rtd.) Sirijagan Committee. Hon: Supreme Court accepted the said Contempt Petition and issued notice to the Government.

3) The Justice (Rtd.) Sirijagan Committee awarded a compensation of Rs. 10,12,500/- to Sri. Jose Sebastian, included in the 5th report of Justice (Rtd) Sirijagan Committee. Of the above compensation awarded Rs. 2,40,000/- was already paid. Since the compensation in a single stray dog victim case is limited to Rs. 5 lakh, Government as per the G.O read as 2nd paper above, directed Akalakkunnam Grama Panchayath to pay the balance compensation of Rs. 2,60,000/-

4) The standing counsel has advised Government to pay full compensation to the petitioner Sri. Jose Sebastian, treating it as a special case since the application for compensation was filed by the petitioner before the Hon. Supreme Court much before the appointment of Justice (Rtd) Sirijagan Committee. The Advocate General in his letter read as 3rd paper above recommended the advice of the standing counsel.

5) Government have examined the matter in detail and sanction is accorded to Secretary, Akalakunnam Grama Panchayat through the Director of Panchayats to pay the balance compensation amounting Rs. 5,12,500/- (Rupees Five lakh twelve thousand and five hundred only) to Sri. Jose Sebastian, the claimant in the 5th report of Justice (Rtd) Sirijagan Committee, from the Own fund or Plan Fund (Service Sector) of the Grama Panchyat with immediate effect.

6) Compliance report in this regard shall be submitted to Government within three days positively.
