ORDER

In the Government order read as 1st paper above, administrative sanction was accorded to procure the following types of buses in Kerala State Road Transport Corporation (KSRTC) by utilizing the plan fund of Rs.50 Crore aliotted under the Head of Account '5055-00-800-79 (P) - Modernization and Quality Improvement of fleet' for the year 2020-21.

- 1. AC Premium Sleeper buses 8 Nos. (Rs.10.40 crore)
- 2. AC Semi Premium seater buses 20 Nos. (Rs.10.80 crore)
- 3. Conventional Air Suspension Buses 72 Nos. (Rs.28.80 crore)

In the Government Order read as 3rd paper above, administrative sanction was accorded for the conversion of 1000 High Speed Diesel (HSD) buses to Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) buses at an estimated cost of Rs.100 crore by utilizing the plan fund allotted under the head of account '5055-00-800-79 (P) - Modernization and Quality Improvement of fleet' for the year 2021-22.

2. The Chairman & Managing Director, KSRTC has informed, as per the letters read as 2nd paper above, that based on the administrative sanction accorded vide Government order read as 1st paper above,

KSRTC has invited e-tenders for the procurement of the buses, released purchase order for procuring 8 Nos. of AC Premium Sleeper buses and released letter of intent for the purchase of 20 Nos. of AC Semi Premium seater buses as well as 72 Nos. of Conventional Air Suspension Buses, the details of which is as shown below:

AC Premium Sleeper buses (8 Nos.)

The Chairman & Managing Director, KSRTC has informed that as per the conditions of the Notice Inviting Tenders, when the chassis is billed in favour of KSRTC and transferred for body building, KSRTC has to make a part payment of 60% of the total agreed price of the chassis as first instalment. It is also informed that the above payments is to be released against Bank Guarantee (BG) only and this necessitates that the bank guarantee is to be got confirmed from the concerned bank directly by KSRTC. The total amount required for the payment of first instalment is Rs.15,71,98,802/-, details of which is as shown below:

AC Premium Sleeper buses (8 Nos.)

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60% of the amount of chassis for one bus = Rs.59,40,000/-60% of the amount of chassis for 8 buses = Rs.4,75,20,000/-

AC Semi - Premium seater buses (20 Nos.)
60% of the amount of chassis for one bus = Rs.13,97,220/60% of the amount of chassis for 20 buses = Rs.2,79,44,402/-

Conventional Air Suspension Buses (72 Nos.)
60% of the amount of chassis for one bus = Rs.11,35,200/60% of the amount of chassis for 72 buses = Rs.8,17,34,400/-

Hence the CMD, KSRTC has requested to sanction and release the above said amounts of Rs.4,75,20,000/-, Rs.2,79,44,402/- and Rs.8,17,34,400/- to KSRTC as plan fund from the head of account '5055-00-800-79 - Modernization and Quality Improvement of fleet'.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to release Rs.15,71,98,802/- (Rupees Fifteen Crore Seventy One Lakh Ninety Eight Thousand Eight Hundered and Two only) under the head of account '5055-00-800-79 (P) - Modernization and Quality Improvement of fleet' to the PSTSB account of KSRTC, for the payment of first instalment for the purchase of buses, as plan fund on the condition that KSRTC should ensure the payment only after the receipt of invoice and bank guarantee. This release is subject to the guidelines stipulated in the Government Orders G.O.(P)No.88/2018/Fin dated 11.06.2018, G.O. (P)No.100/2018/Fin dated 03.07.2018 and Circular No.1/2021/Fin dated 04.01.2021.

ORDER

The Chairman and Managing Director, Kerala State Road Transport Corporation (KSRTC) as per the letter cited as paper 1st above submitted a re-appropriated proposal for the implementation of the scheme 'Modernization and Quality Improvement of fleet' in KSRTC at an estimate cost of Rs.50 crore, as provided in the State Budget under the plan head of account '5055-00-800-79'. Detailed break up and the estimates of the proposal is as follows:

1. Purchase of 8 Nos. of A/C Premium Sleeper Buses

At present KSRTC is not having sleeper buses. But Karnataka State Road Transport Corporation and private operators are operating sleeper buses in Thiruvananthapuram - Bengaluru route and such other interstate routes. Huge potential for operating Sleeper buses in this kind of long distance routes where the passengers desire better facilities than the semi sleeper buses provide to them. Hence KSRTC plans to purchase 8 Nos of Premium segment A/C SLEEPER Buses (with warranty) at an estimate cost of Rs.10.40 crore (Rs.1.30 crore per bus).

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2. Purchase of 20 Nos. of A/C Semi - Premium Seater Buses

At present KSRTC doesn't have semi - premium A/C buses. There is a market for Semi premium seater buses in inter state route targeting middle class passengers. For this purpose KSRTC plans to purchase 20 Nos of A/C semi - premium seater buses (with warranty) at an estimate cost of Rs.10.80 crore (Rs.0.54 crore per bus).

3. Purchase of 72 Nos. of Conventional Air Suspension Buses KSRTC plans to purchase 72 Nos. of conventional air suspension buses for operating as express buses at an estimate cost of Rs.28.80 crore (Rs.0.40 crore per bus).

The above buses will have the following features;

- Only one door
- Sufficient luggage space for long distance passengers
- · PIS & GPS
- Drinking water
- Mobile charger for all seats
- Roof hatches (2 nos.)
- Additional retractable foot board at the entry step to reduce step height so as to make it disabled friendly
- Television and music system (only for A/C buses)
- 2. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord in principle Administrative Sanction for the re-appropriated proposal furnished by the Chairman and Managing Director, KSRTC for the implementation of the scheme 'Modernization and Quality Improvement of fleet' in Kerala State Road Transport Corporation at an estimate amount of Rs.50 crore (Rupees Fifty crore only), subject to the following conditions:
 - 1. All purchases shall be in compliance with the store purchase rules/etendering and other relevant Government orders subject to the concurrence of State Planning Board.
- 2. All the buses to be procured under this scheme shall be operated under the new subsidiary of the KSRTC, namely the KSRTC-SWIFT to be formed as part of the restructing of the corporation and revenue generated these buses shall be kept in a separate bank account to enable repayment of the Bank consortium loan

- 3. A Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (CAMC) shall be formulated for the newly purchased vehicles.
- 4. Adequate training facility shall be provided by the manufacturers of buses to the Drivers and Technical/Mechanical Staff of KSRTC and sufficient spare parts shall be provided to these vehicles for 15 years.
- 5. The Chairman and Managing Director, Kerala State Road Transport Corporation is authorized to take necessary action for the implementation of the scheme, to closely monitor the implementation and to furnish report to Government during all phases of implementation of the scheme.
- 6. Necessary tender procedure should be completed before the implementation of the project. Tender / e-tender and other stipulated formalities shall be followed wherever necessary.
- 7. The expenditure would be met from the provision available under the plan head of account '5055-00-800-79 Modernization and Quality Improvement of fleet'.
- 8. The fund release will be based on actual requirement and the fund released should not be parked in banks.
- 9. Post creation and purchase of vehicles (other than sanction is accorded) are not admissible under the scheme.
- 10. For hiring of project staff/man power as part of project implementation, instructions issued in G.O.(P)No.76/2019/Fin, dated 02.07.2019 and G.O(P)No.81/2019/Fin, dated 09.07.2019 shall be followed.
- 11. The period of completion of the project shall be five months.

<u>ORDER</u>

Administrative sanction was accorded as per Government order read as paper 1st above for an amount of Rs.50.00 Crore for 'Modernization and Quality Improvement of Fleet' under the head of account 5055-00-800-79(P) to Kerala State Road Transport Corporation (KSRTC) during the financial year 2020-2021. Accordingly, proceedings were issued by KSRTC for the purchase of tools and machinery and also tender process initiated for the purchase of 8 numbers of premium super class AC sleeper buses (Rs.10.40 crore), 72 numbers of deluxe air suspension non AC buses (Rs.28.80 crore) and 20 numbers of AC seater buses (Rs.10.80 crore). i.e. a total of 100 buses. However, the amount was not released to KSRTC during 2020-21. Since it is a committed expenditure for the year 2020-21 the amount is proposed to be met during 2021-22 from the budget provision.

2. In the financial year 2021-22 a budget provision of Rs.50 Crore is provided to KSRTC for 'Modernization and Quality Improvement of Fleet', which mainly aims for the conversion of existing High Speed Diesel (HSD) buses into CNG buses. As per the Government order read

as paper 2nd above, administrative sanction is accorded to convert 1000 HSD buses to CNG at an estimated cost of Rs.100 crore, under the head of account 5055-00-800-79 (P).

3. The CMD, KSRTC as per the letters read as paper 3rd above informed that in order to purchase the buses, KSRTC had invited e-tender and the L1 vendors (lowest bid) for AC semi premium and conventional air suspension buses had quoted an amount of Rs.47,12,300/- and Rs.33,78,800/- as against the amount quoted in the primary estimates of Rs.54 lakh and Rs.40 lakh respectively and hence the total amount for the procurement of 100 buses comes only Rs.44,83,19,600/- and thus, there is a savings of Rs.5,16,80,409/- available out of the Rs.50 Crore sanctioned as plan fund for the purchase of buses. The CMD, KSRTC has requested to accord sanction to utilize this savings for the purchase of new 16 conventional air suspension buses additionally. It is also informed that the total amount required for the purchase of 16 Nos. of conventional air suspension buses is Rs.5,40,60,800/-and if the Government accords sanction for the purchase of 16 conventional air suspension buses additionally, by utilizing the savings of Rs. 5,16,80,400/-, KSRTC will be borne the balance amount of Rs.23,80,400/- from its own resources. Component wise break up of expenditure of the proposed 16 new buses is as follows:





As per Government Order read 1st above, Administrative Sanction has been issued for the procurement of 1000 CNG buses by M/s Kerala State Road Transport Corporation (KSRTC) from the special investment scheme (i.e., through KIIFB funding) as announced by Government through the revised Budget Speech 2016-17. However, due to technical factors constraining the procurement and operation of CNG buses, Government have issued revised sanction orders permitting KSRTC for the purchase of 900 diesel buses utilising KIIFB funds. Thus, based on the detailed report submitted by KSRTC, KIIFB has agreed t fund the project which costs Rs.324 Crore and orders were issued vide reference d 3rd above.

Later, Government have issued revised Administrative Sanction for the conversion of 400 Diesel buses to LNG buses and also for the purchase of 310 CNG buses and 50 electric buses on wet lease basis availing loan from KIIFB, vide Government Orders read 4th & 5th above. Accordingly, KSRTC submitted a revised proposal to KIIFB with an objective to mark a shift towards greener and environment friendly bus services. Considering the approval of Government, KIIFB have granted revised funding sanction for a total outlay of Rs.360,91,25,000/- for the project: `TRA008-01: Procurement of 310 CNG buses, 50 Electric buses and conversion of 400 Diesel Buses to LNG buses' as LOAN, , vide Order read 7th above, as noted below.

- a. Procurement of 310 Nos. CNG Buses- Rs.201.5 Crore
- b. Procurement of 50 Nos. Electric Buses on Wet-lease basis & Charging Infrastucture-Rs.57.50
 Crore
- c. Conversion of 400 Nos. Diesel buses to LNG- Rs.100 Crore
- d. Risk management and promotion of innovation- Rs.10 Lakh
- e. Collision Avoidance and Telematics System- Rs 1.81 Crore

Subsequently, KSRTC vide letter No.ML3/005249(A)/19 dated.06.02.2021 had requested for a change in the model of operation of electric buses from Wet lease to CAPEX model by avoiding the demand incentive under the FAME-II scheme. A detailed proposal including the cash flow statement also was forwarded without changing the amount already approved. The main reasons given by KSRTC for considering the OPEX model as impossible are that even after completing two cycles of the tender process, there are no competing operators or available offers for operation on a wet-lease model.

Accordingly, after having examined the revised proposal in detail, sanction is accorded for funding the 'Procurement of 50 Nos. Electric Buses in CAPEX model', with no change in the approved amount involved (ie, Rs.57.50 Cr) with the following additional conditions:

- 1. The project is to be implemented by the new company 'K-SWIFT', which has been incorporated recently vide Government Order read 8th above. Hence, the tendering of the approved components under the project shall be done through "K-SWIFT'.
- 2. All the payments in connection with the project will be released only after executing Tripartite agreement and Repayment /Escrow Agreement by the new SPV (M/s K-SWIFT) entrusted by Transport Department.

The order read 7th above will stand modified to above extent.

Vide reference first above, Managing Director KSRTC has placed a proposal to SCTL for procurement of 100 Electric buses for service in Thiruvananthapuram city area as part of Green Mobility Scheme under the Thiruvananthapuram Smart City Project. The Board of SCTL in their 23rd Meeting held on 27/09/2022 has considered the proposal and resolved to provide an amount of Rs.103.74 Crore being approximate cost for procuring 100 electric buses and authorised MD KSRTC to proceed for tender process subject to following conditions.

To confirm that KSRTC has complied with the procedure prescribed in Store Purchase

Manual while procuring E-Buses

- To enter into a Tripartite agreement with KSRTC and TMC after finalising appropriate terms and conditions for operation of the buses within Thiruvananthapuram Municipal Corporation limits. The above shall be done in accordance with the guidelines of MoHUA regarding the same.
- c) To get assurance from KSRTC to bear all operational expenses pertaining to the buses.
- 2. Administrative Sanction to this project has been approved by 25th meeting of Board of SCTL held on 22/12/2022
- 3. After completed the tender process and subsequent negotiation KSRTC informed in his letter 4th under reference that they have completed the tendering process for the estimated amount of 103.74 Crore and requested for fund release. In terms of the Board decision, a Tri-Partite Agreement between SCTL, Thiruvananthapuram Municipal Corporation and KSRTC SWIFT has been executed on 27/02/2023 with a fund release pattern agreed as below;
 - 30% of the agreed amount will be provided to KSRTC-SWIFT in advance.
 - 30% as second instalment on utilization of first instalment and on receipt of further proposal with added proof of procurement.
 - 40% as final instalment on receipt of utilization of second instalment and on further proposal with added proof of procurement.
- 4. MD KSRTC SWIFT in his letter as reference 6th above has reported that they have placed order for 113 electric buses (53 form M/s PMI Electro Mobility Solutions Pvt Ltd and 60 From M/s VE Commercial Vehicle Ltd) and requested for advance of 30% of the agreed amount in terms of the Tri Partite Agreement Dated 27.02.2023.
- 5. In consideration of the request from the MD KSRTC SWIFT and also in adherence to clause 4a. of payment conditions in the Agreement, sanction is accorded to release an amount of

Rs.31,12,20,000/-(Rupees Thirty one crore twelve lakhs and twenty thousand only) towards 30% of the agreed amount of Rs. 103.74 crore as payment in advance against the order placed for 113 Electric Buses under Smart City Project.

6. The payment shall be effected through electronic transfer to the Bank Account Number 21610200003037 in Pattoor Branch of Federal Bank Ltd in favour of M/s KSRTC SWIFT Ltd.


