- 4. The External Agency, if any, comitted for implementing any project/activity referred above shall be selected in a transparent procedure and the agency will be an accredited agency approved by Government.
- 5. State Police Chief shall monitor the functioning and utilisation of the scheme for upgradation of Scientific Investigation facilities.

State Police Chief shall ensure that the sanctioned amount to be expended in accordance with the existing rules & regulations.
