2. Letter No.PG(2)17806/16 dated 12/03/2020 and 21/12/2020 from the Director, Department of Soil Survey & Soil Conservation

3. Letter No.PG(2)17806/16 dated 18/01/2020 from the Director, Department of Soil Survey & Soil Conservation addressed to the Principal Secretary, Finance Department.

Government have accorded sanction for the renovation of 56 ponds under the scheme 'Renovation of Ponds in Palakkad District' RIDF Tranche XX as per the Government Order cited.

As per the letter dated 12/03/2020, the Director, Department of Soil Survey & Soil Conservation informed that renovation of 46 ponds was completed and due to the non ability to relinquish the land for taking up works and other ownership issues, works in remaining 10 ponds were not commenced. The Director informed that the matter was discussed with the concerned Grama Panchayat and that they had come up with resolution to take up 9 alternative ponds in place of sanctioned ponds in their respective Panchayats. As per the letter 3rd cited, the Director requested sanction for taking up 11 alternate ponds in place of non started projects under RIDF XX tranche. It was also informed that NABARD officials had suggested that the Department of Soil Survey & Soil Conservation may submit relocation proposal for taking up alternate ponds in the Panchayat where scheme was originally sanctioned adhering to the same project cost for consideration of NABARD sanction under RIDF Tranche XX itself, with a view to utilize the amount already sanctioned for the Panchayat and to incur



maximum expenditure under the tranche. The Director also informed that the Officials intimated that NABARD Regional Office could sanction the relocation proposal subject to the condition that the proposals are for the same Panchayat and having same Total Financial Outlay as sanctioned project.

In view of the facts stated above, I am directed to inform you that Government hereby agree to the above proposal of the Director for the implementation of 11 following alternative ponds in place of the nonstarter projects under the scheme 'Renovation of Ponds in Palakkad District' under RIDF Tranche XX, for utilizing the balance amount of ₹348.64 Lakh subject to the condition that the Director should ensure adherence to the tight timeline, while complying with all regulations and should report the progress of the project in the next review meeting to be held on 15.02.2021.


