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**THE KERALA APPROPRIATION (No. 4) BILL, 2024**

THE KERALA APPROPRIATION (No. 4) BILL, 2024

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*BILL*

*to provide for the authorisation of appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala to meet the amounts spent on certain services during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 2017 in excess of the amount granted for those services and for that year.*

*Preamble.*—WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the authorisation of appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala to meet the amounts spent on certain services during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 2017 in excess of the amount granted for those services and for that year;

BE it enacted in the Seventy-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. *Short title.*—This Act may be called the Kerala Appropriation (No. 4) Act, 2024.

2. *Issue of ₹ 95,63,28,730 out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala to meet certain excess expenditure for the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 2017.*—From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala, the sum specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting to the sum of Rupees Ninety Five Crore Sixty Three Lakh Twenty Eight Thousand Seven Hundred and Thirty only shall be deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied to meet the amounts spent for defraying the charges in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 2017 in excess of the amounts granted for those services and for that year.

3. *Appropriation.*—The sums deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala under this Act shall be deemed to have been appropriated for the services and purposes specified in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 2017.

## STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The Bill is introduced in pursuance of clause (1) of Article 204 of the Constitution of India, read with Article 205 thereof, to provide for the appropriation out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala of the moneys to meet the amounts spent on certain services in excess of the amounts granted for those services for the financial year 2016-2017.
